## BRUSHES & TOOLS



1" FLAT BRUSH



1/4" FLAT BRUSH



DETAIL BRUSH



PLASTIC SPOON (PALETTE KNIFE EFFECT)

### 1 PAINT THE BACKGROUND

- Use your 1" flat brush to paint the whole canvas light pink.
- Let it dry, then add a second coat if needed.

TIP: Paint in one direction for the final layer for a smoother finish.

### 2 START THE FLOWERS WITH WHITE

- Use your 1/4" flat brush to loosely paint white circular shapes.
- Use curved strokes to create swirls and spirals.

TIP: Vary the size of your flowers to keep it natural.

### 3 BUILD THE PINK AND RED LAYERS

- Add red into white or pink to create different pink tones.
- Layer using loose circular strokes.

TIP: Leave some white showing for a soft, layered look.

### 4 ADD LEAVES

- Use leaf green and your plastic spoon to stamp or press in leaf shapes.
- Add leaves around and between the flowers.

TIP: Turn the spoon slightly each time for variety.

### 5 ADD YELLOW POPS

- Use yellow to add small round dots throughout the bouquet.
- These are your bright pops of colour!

TIP: Spread them out so they balance the whole painting.

### 6 PAINT THE VASE

- Use white to paint a vase under the bouquet.
- Any shape works—square, rounded, tall, or short!
- Let it dry, then add a second coat if needed.

### 7 ADD THE VASE PATTERN

- Use black and your detail brush to add polka dots.
- Try stripes, dashes, or your own pattern too!

TIP: Vary dot sizes for a fun, hand-painted look.

## FINAL TOUCHES

- Add any extra flower swirls, leaves, yellow dots, or vase details.
- Step back and look at the whole painting.
- Add a few bold marks where needed to bring it all together.
- Add loose green stems for extra movement (optional)!

## A FINAL NOTE

Your style, your brushstrokes, your colours—there's no right or wrong here. Enjoy the process, trust yourself, and most importantly, have fun!
