COLOURS USED

BRUSHES & TOOLS



1" Flat Brush



1/4" Flat Brush



Detail Brush



Template



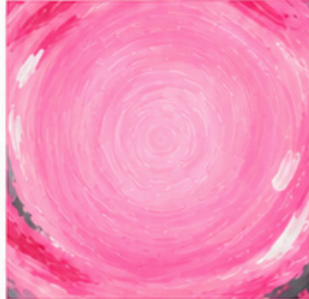
Pencil

1 Paint the Background



Use red and white with your 1" brush to create a soft pink background using loose, curved strokes. Keep the centre lighter and edges slightly darker.

2 Build Texture



Add touches of red, white, and a hint of black near the edges. Blend gently but keep visible brush movement.

TIP: Let the brushstrokes show — don't over-blend.

3 Trace the Glass



Place your template and lightly trace the wine glass shape onto the dry background.

TIP: Keep lines light so they don't show through.

4 Paint the Wine



Fill the wine area with dark red or burgundy. Keep the top slightly curved and add a touch of black for depth.

5 Outline the Glass



Using your detail brush, outline the glass, stem, and base with black or dark grey.

TIP: Loose lines look better than perfect ones.

6 Add Reflections



Use white and grey to add soft, curved highlights along the glass and wine.

TIP: Keep reflections broken and uneven — not solid lines.

FINAL TOUCHES

- Deepen shadows with black or dark red
- Add final white highlights for shine
- Adjust anything that feels unfinished

A FINAL NOTE

Don't worry about making it perfect — this piece comes together through layers and small details. Trust the process and enjoy it!
